GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATIONS

In May 2018 the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) came into legal force, and apply to the information which Hedgerley Historical Society (HHS) holds about its individual members.

Your details are used if HHS needs to contact you about your membership or HHS's activities including meetings and events. All computers holding your membership information are password protected.

1. The following information is held by HHS's Secretary: your name(s), address, postcode, plus email address(es) and telephone number(s) if you have provided them.
2. Your email or postal address is used to send you reminders about HHS subscription renewals, our AGM and to provide details of meetings and events in HHS's programme. Such communication may include information of other local history related matters judged relevant to HHS Members.
3. HHS will only use your personal data for the matters listed and will not disclose any of your personal data to a third party without your explicit permission.

Please read carefully, complete and sign, and return to the HHS Secretary. Please note that in the case of joint renewal, consent given by one individual is taken as consent on the same basis for of all of the individuals renewing their membership on the membership form unless a separate consent form is completed by them.
